Haney Farmers Market Guidelines for All Youth Vendors Including Farm, Craft and Prepared Foods 2008

The Haney Farmers Market wishes to encourage youth participation in our farmers market. We offer three separate categories for Youth Vendors. - Craft, Prepared Food and Farm products.

All products for sale at our market must be crafted, prepared or grown by the youth selling them. We do not allow re-sale of any items.

Market Hours:

The market will take place every Saturday, May to October from 9:00 AM to 2:00 PM in Memorial Peace Park in front of the band stand on 224th St. in Maple Ridge. The Haney Farmers Market will also hold several special markets throughout the year as scheduled on our 2008 application forms and noted with an (*).

Vendors may begin set up at 7am. Your space will be marked with your name. All vendors must remain set up until the market closes (2:00 PM) even if the vendor has sold out of goods. For the safety of vendors, market volunteers and our customers, **vehicles are prohibited in the market area after 8:30 AM.**

GENERAL GUIDELINES - 2008

1. For 2008 there is a Youth Vendor membership fee of \$5.00.
2. All Youth Vendor spaces will cost \$2.00 per market day.
3. All Youth Vendors under the age of 12 years must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
4. Haney Farmers market will provide one 10 x 10 tent for 4 youth vendors. A maximum of 4 youth vendors may set up under this tent. Youth Vendors will each be given a space to set up a table no larger than a card table (approx. 2 ½ feet long).
5. If a Youth Vendor wishes to use a small (**2 ½ foot**) table with their own umbrella instead they may do so. Please note this on your application form. The market coordinator will decide where your space will be.
6. Due to space limitations you must pre-register and receive confirmation for the dates you want to sell.
7. Youth Vendors must provide their own tables (**no larger than 2 ½ ' long**), chairs and display equipment.
8. All products must be clearly and competitively priced.
9. All Vendors are responsible for the reasonable care and clean up of their stall area. All trash must be removed at the end of the day.
10. Vendors must display a sign identifying their business name. The sign must not exceed or be placed outside the area of the Youth Vendor's space. Signs must be legible and clearly visible.
11. Youth Vendors must conduct themselves in a business like manner respecting their fellow vendors.

Craft Vendors

1. All craft vendors must have every item they wish to sell juried before selling in the market.

Prepared Food Vendors

1. The Haney Farmers Market Society is required to have a copy of the parent or guardian's ***Level 1 Food Safe Certificate** on file for all prepared food vendors. Please include this certificate or a photocopy with your application and note that your application will be incomplete and declined if it is missing.
2. You will also need to complete an ***Application-Sale Of Home Prepared, Non-Potentially Hazardous Food At Temporary Food Markets** form from Fraser Health. Send this in to the Fraser Health office at least 14 days prior to your first market.

PLEASE NOTE; If you have filled out the (Application Sale of Home Prepared, Non-Potentially Hazardous Food At Temporary Food Markets) **in a previous season and you are preparing EXACTLY THE SAME food items then you do not have to re-send the form, BUT YOU MUST E-MAIL US AT - haneyfarmmarket@hotmail.com with "ATTENTION EILEEN" in the subject line to tell us that all products are the same.**

Farm Vendors

1. If you are certified organic you must display your certification at your space.
2. All scales in use at the market must be certified LEGAL FOR TRADE.
3. Eggs must be kept refrigerated
